APPLICATION FOR PERMITS AND CERTIFICATES

This is a reminder that before carrying out renovation, expansion or construction work, even if you are planning to demolish whether for your home, your garage, an agricultural building or a shed, the installation of a swimming pool, a silo, for a well or a septic system you must always obtain a permit **beforehand**. You need to apply for your permits in advance! Please note that the inspector has thirty (30) days to issue a permit or certificate of authorization.

Work carried out without a permit may not comply with the standards and regulations in force. Anyone who undertakes work without the necessary permits or authorizations can be given a ticket or a fine, and even demolition could be ordered.



FARM EQUIPMENT ON OUR ROADS

This is the beginning of the busy season for many of our local farmers, you will most likely encounter tractors and other farm equipment on the road. When traveling on our roads, we ask all drivers to be alert, patient and courteous with these large and slower moving vehicles.

As for the farm equipment operators, when travelling on the road, if you leave a trail of mud, we kindly ask that you clean the pavement immediately and when driving in and out of your field please be careful not to damage the pavement on OUR roads.

REMINDER

A quick reminder that the third tax installment will be due on June 9, 2025.

We would like to remind you that the Canada Post workers' strike is imminent. Therefore, it is important for you to make arrangements to pay your third tax installment, on or before June 9, to avoid interest charges.

Several payment options are available:

Online payment: You can pay your account through your banking institution (CIBC, BMO, or Desjardins) using the "Bill Payment" option with your 10-digit tax number shown on your tax account. Please select Elgin, Municipality of, Tax as the supplier.

Payment by check: You can mail your check to City Hall at the following address: 933 Chemin de la 2^e Concession, Elgin, QC J0S 2E0.

In-person payment: We welcome you to our office for cash or check payments. A slot in the door is also available for depositing your payment outside of business hours.

Dear Residents,

In the interest of everyone's safety, we encourage you to trim tree branches along your driveway. This will allow fire trucks and ambulances easier access to your residence in the event of an emergency.

Secure your pool to prevent any risk of drowning

In order to limit access to pools and protect young children from drowning, rules apply to all outdoor residential pools that can hold 60 cm (23.6 in) of water or more (above ground, in-ground or even removable (inflatable or other)).

The regulation applies to all pools, regardless of the date they were installed. Owners of a pool installed before November 1, 2010, will have to comply with the standards for their installations before September 30, 2025. All other pool owners must comply with the rules in force.

Contact the Municipality of Elgin to apply for a building permit for a pool or any related facilities (fence, deck, terrace, etc.).
